*****After this schedule is completed the league will be split into an upper and a lower pool based on total wins (If there is a tie the break will be determined by head to head). There will be six teams per pool. Each team will play the other five teams in their pool. The league will pay 1st and 2nd place in the upper pool and 1st place in the lower pool. Pool play dates: August, 10, 17, 24, 31 and September 7. *****

Playing Format and General Rules Volleyball

Games start at 6:15 with a 15 minute grace period. Failure to begin within 15 minutes grace period will result in a forfeit. If a team fails to show up, the opposing team will take all five wins. No coolers allowed. Please remember we are here to have fun. Be respectful of your opponents. Enjoy the volleyball season and have a great time!

- Volley for serve or side, rotate sides and serve stays on side.
- Teams must have six players or less with no less than two women at all times and no less than four players.
- All games will be played using **RALLY SCORING** to 25.
- There will be a point scored on every score of the ball.
- Offense will score on a defense miss or out of bounds hit.
- Defense will score on an offensive miss, out of bounds hit, or a serve into the net.
- Game will be played to 25 pts. Must win by 2 points.
- Let serve is a legal serve.
- There is absolutely NO blocking a serve.
- Serves may be made from anywhere behind the end line and may be struck under or over arm with any part of the hand, fist or arm.
- The server's foot cannot touch or cross the base line.
- A team may hit the ball three times to return it, but no player can hit the ball twice in a row including if it hits one part of their body and then rebounds to another part.
- If the ball contacts a player with any body part, it is considered a legal hit. Examples: head, foot or shoulder.
- A team scores a point if it hits the ball and it lands in the opposition's court.
- Rallies can be lost by hitting the ball out of play or into the net, or if a player touches the net with any part of his or her body while playing the ball. If there is a dispute the point must be replayed.
- Shots may be blocked before they cross the net, as long as the blocker does not touch the net.
- A block is not counted as a hit.
- Back row players cannot spike the ball (hit it above net level) from in front of the attack line.
- The ball can be directed anywhere into the opponent's courts. If the ball touches the boundary line the ball is considered in.
- To win a set, a team must have 25 points with a two point break over the opposition. The match continues indefinitely until this is the case. Teams will receive one point for each game won. Five games are played per match.
- No carrying the ball. Disputes will be replayed.
- Each team is allowed two time outs per set.
- Teams are responsible for rescheduling rain outs or any other rescheduling due to team necessity. All make up games must be played prior to the last Wednesday of scheduled matches.
- It is the responsibility of the winning team to call in their scores to Uncle Mike's at 635-9042 by the following day or they will forfeit their wins.
